Christopher Stuart, British Ambassador, Mongolia

HMA Stuart joined the Department of Environment having worked as a development chemist. After 7 years as First Secretary Science and Technology in Tokyo, he became Head of Near East and North Africa Unit in UK Trade and Investment (UKTI). He has held roles as Deputy Consul General and Head of Investment UKTI Osaka, Consul General and Head of UKTI for West Japan, Director Corporate Development, Energy Technologies Institute in UK. He has been British Ambassador to Mongolia since 2012.



Minister S. Oyun MP

Minister Oyun has been a Member of Parliament, since 1998, is a Member of the Standing Committees on Security and Foreign Policy, Social Policy and Budget, and of the Parliament Working Group on Mining Policy and Strategic Deposits. She was Chair of the Parliament Sub-Committee on the UN Millennium Development Goals and Poverty Reduction 2005–2008 and Leader of the Democratic Coalition Caucus in Parliament 2004 - 2005. Founder and Head of the Zorig Foundation and the Civil Will Green Party, she holds a Ph.D. in Earth Sciences from Cambridge University, GB.



Chuluunbat Ochirbat, Vice Minister of Economic Development

Dr. Chuluunbat was educated at the School of International Relations, Moscow and holds a Doctorate in Economics. He was an MP from 2008 to 2012 and Head of Parliament's Committee on Budget. From 2000 he served as Central Bank of Mongolia' Governor for six years and has held roles as Deputy Governor of Central Bank of Mongolia and First Deputy Director of City Bank.



Mr. Randolph S. Koppa, President, Trade and Development Bank of Mongolia

Mr.Koppa graduated in International Relations from the University of Wiconsin. He is President of TDB, President of TDB Capital LLC and Chairman of the Mongolian Mortgage Corporation (MIK) and on the Board of Directors of the Business Council of Mongolia and the Association of Development Financing Institutions in Asia and the Pacific (ADFIAP).



Professor Peter Head, Director, The Ecological Sequestration Trust

Peter Head CBE, is a civil and structural engineer and a recognised world leader in the sustainable development of cities. He is the Executive Chairman of The Ecological Sequestration Trust. As Director of Planning, Arup between 2004 and 2011, he directed work on the Dongtan Eco City Planning project and became an advisor to the Singapore Government on their plans for greening the city and the economy. He has won many awards for his work including the Award of Merit of IABSE, the Royal Academy of Engineering's Silver Medal and the Prince Philip Award for Polymers in the Service of Mankind, the Sir Frank Whittle medal of the Royal Academy of Engineering for a lifetime contribution to the well-being of the nation through environmental innovation. In 2008 he was named by the Guardian Newspaper as one of 50 people that could 'save the planet'.



E. Tuvshintugs, Director, Economic Research Institute

Tuvshintugs Batdelger is a director of Economic Research Institute and Professor of Economics at the National University of Mongolia. He has successfully led research teams of SES on policy analysis – impact of economic crisis on Mongolian economy, impact assessment of big strategic mines on Mongolian economy and assessment of financial environment for businesses in Mongolia.



Kh. Lkamaa, Stakeholder Superintendent, Oyu Tolgoi

Lkamaa has been Superintendent Stakeholder Engagement at Oyu Tolgoi LLC since 2011. Formerly Director of Business Development Department for the Chono Corporation she has a history of management roles with international NGOs including Pact and GTZ. She was educated in Mongolia, Australia and Korea.



Dr. Khuldorj, Vice President for Research and International Relations, UB Science University

A respected member of the scientific community, with a doctorate in Econometrics from Moscow, Khuldorj was a Research Fellow at the MAS from 1976 – 1982. Thereafter he has held the following roles: Director of Planning and International Relations for the State Committee of Science and Technology, Director General of Economic Cooperation in the National Development Ministry and Deputy Head of Law in the Parliament Secretariat and since 2012, Vice President of Ulaanbaatar Science University for Research and Foreign Relations.
